Intensive Home-Based Treatment (IHBT/ICT):

96% of participants remained at home, avoiding residential treatment or other out-of-home placement.

Toddlers and Preschoolers Succeeding (TAPS)

95% of children stayed in preschool.

Building Resilience in Children (BRIC):

95% of teachers improved their knowledge of managing social/emotional concerns.

97%

Violence and Substance Use Prevention Programs:

97% of students gained knowledge on handling conflict.

98% of students reported abstaining from or reducing substance use after the program.
